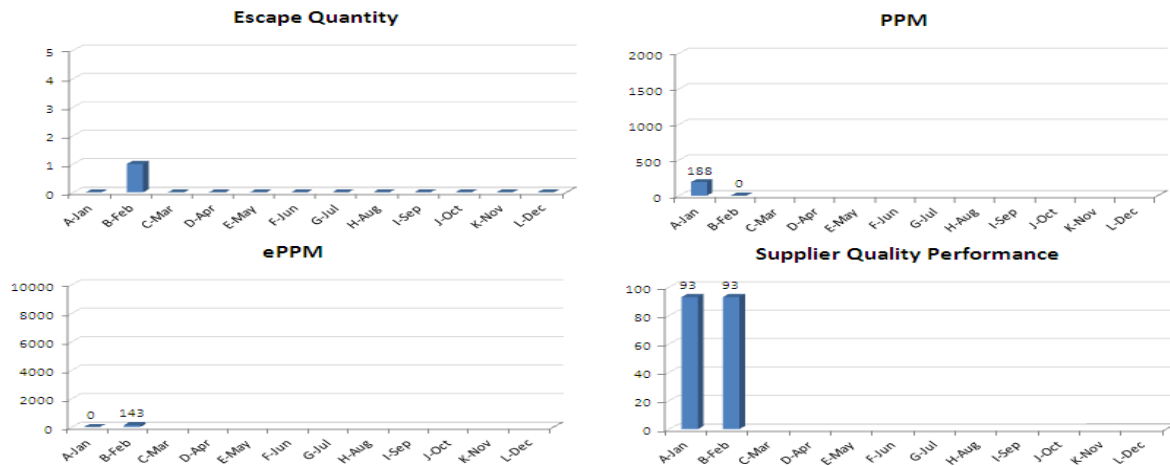
In current issue of the quality bulletin, we would like to inform you about changes that have been introduced to SCORECARD – describing supplier's quality performance. The changes were implemented as of beginning of the year 2012.

Scorecard delivered to you will now include only the information put in the form of charts as you can see below.

First chart “Escape Quantity” describes quantity of quality escapes generated by the supplier in a specific month.

Second chart “ePPM” shows ratio of quantity of nonconforming parts which were detected in WSK and were not previously declared on quality notification (ZN form) to WSK vs. quantity of one million delivered parts.

Next chart is entitled “PPM” shows ratio of quantity of nonconforming parts which were declared on quality notification (ZN form) to WSK vs. quantity of one million delivered parts.

Last chart “Supplier Quality Performance” is summary of quality performance, 90% of the total score in this chart is based on ePPM and PPM in ratio 80% / 20%. The remaining 10% of the total score is divided between other quality tools that the supplier may have (certified quality management system according to AS9100, implemented DQCR program, MCS/LCS approval). Based on that last chart suppliers are qualified into one of the following groups which describe the level of excellence that the supplier has achieved:

L1 – Excellent supplier (90-100)

L2 – Good supplier (80-89)

L3 – Acceptable supplier (50-79)

L4 – Supplier in this group is required to present a strong and complete plan of corrective actions (0-49)
