

Dear Suppliers,

As part of UTC’s ongoing continuous improvement activity, significant revisions have been made to the ASQR09.2 document. The revision reflects the ongoing initiative to align UTC divisions in a One Company approach.

The revised document clarifies and streamlines the requirements of each UPPAP element. Among the more significant changes are:

- Reduction of “Interim Approval” classes and clarified requirements,
- Change notification now submitted via ASQR-01 Form2 (available on UTC website),
- Appendix A added do define additional member-specific requirements,
- Member Specific Reference Guide and enhanced UPPAP support documentation added to the UPPAP Toolbox to provide additional guidance and clarification,

Suppliers are expected to review the document in its entirety and incorporate it into their systems and processes. All changes are to be implemented by April 1st, 2016 based on the table below:

Supplier Current State	Requirement
An Interim or Full Level approval already achieved to ASQR-09.2, Rev. 0	Allowed to continue shipping production parts with the current UPPAP approval level of a part number until new submission is required by the MFP in accordance with ASQR-09.2 Rev. 1.
UPPAP activity has begun, but no Interim or Full Approval achieved for that part number	Shall meet all requirements of Rev.1 in order to ship production parts after April 1st, 2016. Prior to April 1st, 2016, approval to submission levels in Rev 0 or Rev. 1 is allowed.
