

Dear Supplier,

As you may be aware, Kobe Steel in Japan disclosed in October of 2017 (see below link) that they have produced and shipped product that did not meet required specifications.

Broadly, the product categories are defined as follows:
☐ Aluminum products (flat rolled, extrusions)
☐ Copper products (strips, tubes)
☐ Aluminum castings and forgings

We are requesting that you assess your entire value streams to determine if any of your manufacturing processes for Pratt & Whitney Rzeszów products have been impacted by this issue. This is very urgent so a response is required by end of October 31st.

The assessment has determined that PWR product contains Kobe material. Your site vendor code, the applicable part numbers and associated timeframes when those parts were produced from suspected material to the contacts identified below:
