Dear Suppliers,

In reference to Eagle Eye 20-5 for Pratt US parts, we inform you about correct interpretation of paragraph 4.11 from marking specification PWA310 revision BH:

“Required identification numbers (item number, vendor code number, serial number, etc.) may be arranged on separate lines; or consecutive identification number on the same line shall be separated by a distance no less than three spaces. The separation or division of the digits of a human readable identification number (including any corresponding prefixes) will not be objectionable provided the digits are in sequence and there can be no misinterpretation of the information.”

Purpose of this bulletin is to clarify spacing between marking elements, and correct interpretation of **DISTANCE NO LESS THAN THREE SPACES**, if marking is done in line. Below are examples of conforming and non-conforming use of space between marking elements:

Conforming:

77445ASSY1234567-01SK01A**bbb**MFR-98765**bbb**SUPCODE

Non-conforming:

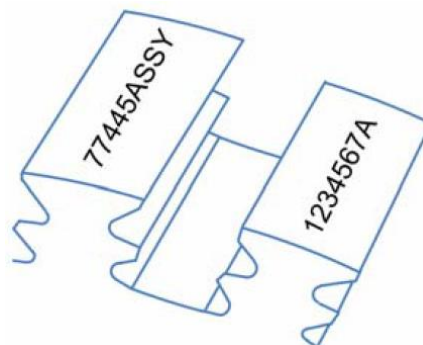
77445ASSY1234567-01SK01A**b**MFR-98765**b**SUPCODE

Where “**b**” represents a character space.

Characters of a single marking element may be also separated or divided provided they are in sequence and there can be no misinterpretation of the information.

77445ASSY

In this case this does not affect the spacing requirement between multiple marking elements.
