Dear Suppliers,

This Quality Bulletin was issued to highlight limitations on part marking of 32Cxxx parts produced to PWC drawings ordered for P&W US end use.

Parts 32Cxxx designed by PWC but manufactured for P&W US end use, this information can be found in P&W Poland purchase order, does not require PWC trademark 4-58 marking according to CPW920 rev K paragraph 8. Below example of purchase order note for parts designed by PWC but manufactured for P&W US end use:

Material/services shall meet P&W requirements (PWC design)
or
PWA end use, PWC Design

According to CPW920 rev. K, paragraph 8.1.2 trademark applies only as per trademark clause in purchase order. If there is no trademark clause in purchase order it shall not be marked.

Quality clause with SQOP-01-01 note in Purchase Order does not require trademark on the parts. There need to be additional clause as stated above.

Please review your 32Cxxx parts manufactured to P&W Poland orders with P&W US end use and when you notice trademark on the parts, part marking need to be changed and trademark removed. Please implement this change as soon as possible on new production lots.

For all details with changed marking please submit partial FAI for marking change approval. Please follow instruction 01/ESCO on how to proceed with FAI submission.
